The Center for Job Ordering Contracting Excellence (CJE) was formed 22-years ago by a group interested in growing the awareness of Job Order Contractors nationally for public funded facilities. The first meeting took place at Arizona State University to discuss the successes and failures of Job Order Contracting (JOC), as well as the future of the JOC industry.

Today, CJE has been designated as the industry's association and resource center. It consists of members from all areas of the construction industry, including publicly funded facilities owners and managers, purchasing professionals, JOC contractors, subcontractors, engineering firms, lawyers, program consultants, unit price book & data publishers. It is the only not-for-profit entity voted by Industry as the safe, non-biased resource for job order contracting standards, best practices and information.

CJE's mission is to promote a cost effective, efficient, performance-based, high quality Job Order Contracting project delivery system through the development and education of the industry. Through education partnership with Arizona State University's Alliance for Construction Excellence, CJE provides a framework for the Certified JOC Professional (CJP) program.

CJE is non-profit organization headquartered in Washington, DC led by a seven-member Board of Directors. Its committees include Membership, Legislative Affairs, and Education to focus on specific aspects of JOC and CJE that are critical to the success of both the industry and the organization. Its regional chapters offer a forum for JOC Best Practices on the local level.
